

# Openwork Eyelet Scarf

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## Abbreviations:

CO - cast on  
K - knit  
P - purl  
ST/STS - stitch/stitches  
YF - yarn to the front  
BO - bind off

## Openwork Eyelet Stitch Pattern:

*Knit in multiples of 3.*

**Row 1:** (Wrong side) Purl all sts.

**Row 2:** (Right Side) K2, \* yf, K3, with left handed needle lift the first of the 3 sts just knitted OVER the last 2; repeat from \* to the last st, K1.

**Row 3:** Purl all sts.

**Row 4:** K1, \* K3, with left handed needle lift the first of the 3 sts just knitted OVER the last 2, yf; repeat from \* to the last 2 sts, K2.



## Shopping List

- Size 7, US, straight needles
- 170 yards of DK weight luxury Yarn
- 1 Tapestry needle

*Design note: Yarntini's Silk Cashmere, in the Peaknits colorway, was used for the model*



# The Openwork Eyelet Scarf's Instructions:

1. CO 30 sts.
2. Row 1 – 3: K all 30 sts.
3. **REPEAT** Rows 1 – 4 of the openwork eyelet stitch pattern (see page 1) until you are 1 inch short of length that you want your scarf to be.
4. Last 3 rows: K all 30 sts.
5. BO.
6. Use tapestry needle to weave yarn tails into the back of the scarf.
7. Block your scarf following any 'wash and care' restrictions for the yarn that you selected.



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
